SHRI GURU GOBIND SINGH

Shri Guru Gobind Singh is the tenth Guru of the Sikhs.

He was born on December 26, 1666 in Patna city, the capital of Bihar.

He was only son of Shri Guru Teg Bahadur, the 9th Guru and mata Gujri Ji.

He founded 'Khalsa Panth' on April 13, 1699 in Anandpur Sahib.

He, his entire family and parents sacrificed their lives for the humanity.

FOUR SAHIBZADAS

Shri Guru Gobind Singh had four sons.

- Sahibzada Ajit Singh
- Sahibzada Jujhar Singh
- Sahibzada Fateh Singh
- Sahibzada Jorawar Singh

Both elder sons sacrificed their lives in the battle field of Chamkaur sahib in 1705. At that time Sahibzada Ajit Singh was 18 years and Sahibzada Jujhar Singh was 14 years. Both Younger sons were killed by the Mughals in 1705 at Sirhind-Fatehgarh Sahib. At that time Sahibzada Fateh Singh was 9 years old and Sahibzada Jujhar was 6 years old.

Four Sahibzadas are our Role-models.

HISTORY OF RUPNAGAR

- It's another name is Ropar.
- It is named after Rupsen, the son of a king Rakeshwar who ruled in 11th century.
- This city is on the bank of River Satluj.
- The city has been prominent part of Indus valley civilization.
- There is an Archeological Museum in the city proving the best of life of people during the civilization.
- Maharaja Ranjit Singh and Lord William Bentinck signed a treaty of friendship at Ropar on October 31, 1831.
- It is a prominent place in the Sikh history.
